## A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the month of April 2023 as "Autism Acceptance Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Autism spectrum disorder is a complex disability
- 4 requiring greater recognition, understanding and acceptance to
- 5 ensure that all individuals living with autism spectrum disorder
- 6 are accurately diagnosed and appropriately supported throughout
- 7 their lives; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Autism spectrum disorder is a developmental
- 9 disability resulting in varying levels of impairment of an
- 10 individual's ability to learn, develop healthy interactive
- 11 behaviors and understand verbal, nonverbal and reciprocal
- 12 communication; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Autism is defined by a certain set of behaviors and
- 14 is a "spectrum disorder" that affects individuals differently
- 15 and to varying degrees; and
- 16 WHEREAS, There is no known single cause of autism, but
- 17 increased awareness, funding and acceptance can help families

- 1 today; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Although a cure for autism spectrum disorder has not
- 3 been found, individuals living with autism spectrum disorder can
- 4 be assisted in reaching their greatest potential through
- 5 accurate early diagnosis, appropriate education and
- 6 intervention; and
- 7 WHEREAS, According to the Centers for Disease Control and
- 8 Prevention, approximately 1 in 44 American children are living
- 9 with autism spectrum disorder; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The number of adults living with autism spectrum
- 11 disorder is expected to increase dramatically over the next few
- 12 years as adolescents age into adulthood; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Department of Human Services created the Office
- 14 of Developmental Programs, which includes the Bureau of Autism
- 15 Services, to provide expertise and support for all agencies
- 16 serving Pennsylvanians living with autism spectrum disorder;
- 17 therefore be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the month of April 2023
- 19 as "Autism Acceptance Month" in Pennsylvania and urge the
- 20 observance throughout this Commonwealth for the benefit of all
- 21 individuals living with autism spectrum disorder and their
- 22 families.
