A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the month of October 2018 as "Pennsylvania
- Pharmacists Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Pharmacy is one of the oldest and most trusted of
- 4 the health professions concerned with the health and well-being
- 5 of all individuals; and
- 6 WHEREAS, There are over 25,000 pharmacists licensed in this
- 7 Commonwealth who provide services to assure the rational and
- 8 safe use of all medications; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The use of medication, as a cost-effective
- 10 alternative to more expensive medical procedures, is becoming a
- 11 major force in moderating overall health care costs; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Today's powerful medications require greater
- 13 attention to the manner in which they are used by different
- 14 patient population groups, both clinically and demographically;
- 15 and
- 16 WHEREAS, It is important that all users of prescription and
- 17 nonprescription medications, and their caregivers, be

- 1 knowledgeable about and share responsibility for their own drug
- 2 therapy; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Pharmacists are specifically educated with a focus
- 4 and level of expertise on medication therapy that exceeds that
- 5 of other health care providers; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Pharmacists are ideally suited to work
- 7 collaboratively with other health care providers and patients to
- 8 improve medication use and outcomes by providing services
- 9 through medication therapy management; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Pharmacists provide both expertise and accessibility
- 11 which are crucial for patients to fully optimize access to
- 12 medications that are not self-administered, such as
- 13 immunizations; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Pharmacists are best positioned to help ensure
- 15 patients are adherent to their medications and provide patient
- 16 care that ensures optimal medication therapy outcomes; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Pharmacists deserve fair reimbursement and
- 18 compensation for the knowledge, education, advice and services
- 19 they provide to patients; and
- 20 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Pharmacists Association has
- 21 declared October as "Pennsylvania Pharmacists Month" in
- 22 conjunction with "American Pharmacists Month," with the theme
- 23 "Know Your MEDICINES Know Your PHARMACIST"; therefore be it
- 24 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of October 2018
- 25 as "Pennsylvania Pharmacists Month" in Pennsylvania; and be it
- 26 further
- 27 RESOLVED, That the Senate urge all residents of this
- 28 Commonwealth to acknowledge the valuable services pharmacists
- 29 provide to ensure safe, affordable and beneficial pharmaceutical
- 30 care services and products in this Commonwealth.
