A RESOLUTION

- Designating March 26, 2013, as "Epilepsy Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Epilepsy is a neurological condition that is
- 4 sometimes referred to as a seizure disorder and characterized by
- 5 recurring seizures; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Epilepsy affects more than 200,000 Pennsylvanians
- 7 and their families; and
- 8 WHEREAS, One in 26 people will develop epilepsy in his or her
- 9 lifetime; and
- 10 WHEREAS, More than 209,000 Pennsylvanians live with epilepsy
- 11 or a seizure disorder; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Up to 50,000 Americans die each year from seizures
- 13 and related causes, including sudden unexplained death in
- 14 epilepsy; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The Epilepsy Foundation affiliates in this
- 16 Commonwealth, the Epilepsy Foundation of Eastern Pennsylvania

- 1 and the Epilepsy Foundation of Western and Central Pennsylvania,
- 2 lead the fight to stop seizures, find a cure and overcome the
- 3 challenges created by epilepsy; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The Epilepsy Foundation affiliates in this
- 5 Commonwealth are dedicated to ensuring that all people with
- 6 seizures and epilepsy are able to participate in all experiences
- 7 of life; and
- 8 WHEREAS, State funding in this Commonwealth currently
- 9 supports Statewide Epilepsy Foundation programs that provide
- 10 technical assistance, training and support to this
- 11 Commonwealth's school nurses, teachers and students on seizure
- 12 recognition and first aid; and
- 13 WHEREAS, State funding in this Commonwealth also currently
- 14 supports Statewide Epilepsy Foundation programs that provide
- 15 patient education, public awareness, information and referral
- 16 services for children and their families living with seizures in
- 17 this Commonwealth; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Both of the Epilepsy Foundation affiliates in this
- 19 Commonwealth are celebrating 40 years of service and dedication
- 20 to communities of this Commonwealth; and
- 21 WHEREAS, The prevention and control of epilepsy can be
- 22 achieved through continued community education and awareness
- 23 programs; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth has supported the creation and
- 25 expansion of epilepsy support services and awareness programs
- 26 through Federal and State appropriations; and
- 27 WHEREAS, The Epilepsy Foundation affiliates in Pennsylvania
- 28 in partnership with the Department of Health since 1994 have
- 29 been serving the needs of Pennsylvanians who live with seizures;

- 1 WHEREAS, The epilepsy community recognizes March 26, 2013, as
- 2 Purple Day to promote epilepsy awareness and education
- 3 throughout the world; therefore be it
- 4 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate March 26, 2013, as
- 5 "Epilepsy Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 6 RESOLVED, That the Senate congratulate the Epilepsy
- 7 Foundation of Eastern Pennsylvania and the Epilepsy Foundation
- 8 of Western and Central Pennsylvania on more than 40 years of
- 9 dedication and Statewide service to the community of this
- 10 Commonwealth.
