1 2	Designating the month of October 2016 as "Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, More than 6 million Americans, or 11% of school-age
4	children and 4% of adults, have been diagnosed with attention
5	deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD); and
6	WHEREAS, ADHD is one of the most common childhood disorders
7	and can continue through adolescence and adulthood; and
8	WHEREAS, ADHD is a nondiscriminatory disorder affecting
9	people of every age, gender, IQ, religion and socioeconomic
10	background; therefore be it
