A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of April 28 through May 5, 2019, as "Days of Remembrance of the Victims of the Holocaust" in
- 3 Pennsylvania.
- 4 WHEREAS, From 1933 to 1945, six million Jews were murdered in
- 5 the Nazi Holocaust as part of a systematic pogrom of genocide,
- 6 and millions of other people perished as victims of Nazism; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The people of this Commonwealth should always
- 8 remember the atrocities committed by the Nazis so that such
- 9 horrors are never repeated and continually rededicate themselves
- 10 to the principle of equal justice for all people; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The people of this Commonwealth should remain
- 12 eternally vigilant against all tyranny and recognize that
- 13 bigotry provides a breeding ground for tyranny to flourish; and
- 14 WHEREAS, May 2, also recognized as 27 Nisan 5779 in the
- 15 Hebrew calendar, has been designated internationally as a Day of
- 16 Remembrance of Victims of the Nazi Holocaust, known as Yom
- 17 Hashoah; and

- 1 WHEREAS, It is appropriate for the people of this
- 2 Commonwealth to join in the international commemoration;
- 3 therefore be it
- 4 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of April 28
- 5 through May 5, 2019, as "Days of Remembrance of the Victims of
- 6 the Holocaust" in Pennsylvania in memory of the victims of the
- 7 Holocaust in the hope that we may strive to overcome prejudice
- 8 and inhumanity through education, vigilance and resistance.
