A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of April 2021 as "Pennsylvania Community College Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, For 58 years, this Commonwealth's community colleges
- 4 have provided accessible and affordable higher education,
- 5 workforce training and transfer opportunities for millions of
- 6 Pennsylvania residents; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania community colleges serve more than a
- 8 quarter of a million students across all of this Commonwealth's
- 9 counties, and 97% of credit students are residents; and
- 10 WHEREAS, One out of every four undergraduates of this
- 11 Commonwealth attends a community college; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Community colleges serve nontraditional students,
- 13 part-time students, dislocated workers and veterans in this
- 14 Commonwealth; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Community colleges offer increased access through
- 16 online education courses and programs, allowing students to
- 17 build their academic credentials and certifications while

- 1 maintaining their work schedules and family responsibilities;
- 2 and
- 3 WHEREAS, Community colleges offer the most affordable pathway
- 4 to the baccalaureate through transfer and articulation
- 5 agreements to ensure that students seamlessly transition from
- 6 community college to a four-year degree, with more than 35,000
- 7 students transferring each year; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Community colleges continue to graduate students in
- 9 many of the high-demand and high-growth industries vital to this
- 10 Commonwealth's economy, particularly in health care, public
- 11 safety, manufacturing and energy; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Community colleges offer individualized credit and
- 13 noncredit courses and programs that enhance the workforce
- 14 pipeline and stimulate this Commonwealth's economy; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Community colleges have developed 40 new or
- 16 redesigned programs in response to regional needs of employers
- 17 and workforce trends; and
- 18 WHEREAS, More than 1,800 employers throughout this
- 19 Commonwealth have contracted with community colleges to provide
- 20 training for employees, and 77,000 employees have been trained
- 21 by community colleges throughout Pennsylvania; therefore be it
- 22 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of April 2021
- 23 as "Pennsylvania Community College Month" in Pennsylvania; and
- 24 be it further
- 25 RESOLVED, That the Senate encourage all residents to
- 26 recognize, appreciate and support the contributions these
- 27 institutions make to their communities and our Commonwealth.
