1 WHEREAS, Section 30-15-9 of the Rhode Island General Laws provides that the

2 General Assembly by concurrent resolution, may terminate a state of disaster emergency at any

3 time and any executive orders issued pursuant thereto; and

4 WHEREAS, On March 9, 2020, Governor Raimondo issued Executive Order 20-02

5 executing her power to declare a state of emergency due to the dangers to health and life posed by

6 SARS-CoV-2; and

7 WHEREAS, Executive Order 20-02 was further extended by Governor McKee through

- 8 December 11, 2022, and on December 9, 2022, Executive Order 20-02 was once again extended
- 9 through January 10, 2023; now, therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That this General Assembly of the State of Rhode Island hereby terminates

11 Executive Order 20-02 in accordance with Section 30-15-9 of the Rhode Island General Laws and

12 all Executive Orders; and be it further

- 13 RESOLVED, That the Secretary of State be and hereby is authorized and directed to
- 14 transmit a duly certified copy of this resolution to the Honorable Daniel McKee, Governor of the
- 15 State of Rhode Island.
