It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Legislative findings. The general assembly finds and declares that the intent
- 2 in enacting the 2018 amendments to § 34-7-4 ("right of footway denied") is not to change the
- 3 meaning or effect of the prior law but, instead, to make what was originally intended
- 4 unmistakably clear. Nothing in this act shall be construed to limit the public rights accrued under
- 5 the doctrine of the implied dedication.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 34-7-4 of the General Laws in Chapter 34-7 entitled "By Possession
- 7 and Prescription" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 8 34-7-4. Right of footway denied.
- 9 No private right of footway, except claimed in connection with a right to pass with
- carriages, shall be acquired by prescription or adverse use for any length of time. 10

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage. 11
