RELATING TO HEALTH AND SAFETY -- PROGRAMS FOR FIRE DEPARTMENTS

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 23-28.4-5 and 23-28.4-5.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 23-28.4 1 2 entitled "Safety and Health Programs for Fire Departments" are hereby amended to read as follows: 3 4 23-28.4-5. Implementation plan. -- Each applicable fire department in the state shall formulate a written plan to implement the requirements of NFPA 1500 not more than one 5 hundred twenty days (120) after July 10, 1990 which shall be updated annually and a copy shall 6 7 be given to the director of labor and training to be kept on file, and a copy shall be given to the bargaining agent representing employees within the fire department. A copy of each applicable 8 9 fire department's NFPA 1500 implementation plan shall be forwarded by the department of labor 10 and training to the NFPA 1500 Implementation Plan Review Committee, as established pursuant to section 23-28.4-5.1, within thirty (30) days after its receipt by the department of labor and 11 12 training. The plan shall identify each specific requirement of NFPA 1500 for which the fire 13 department currently complies and each specific requirement for which corrective action must be 14 initiated for compliance. The plan shall include a timetable for corrective action. The written plan 15 shall be made available for review by any fire department employee and/or employee 16 representative. Compliance for each specific requirement of NFPA 1500 shall be accomplished 17 not later than three (3) years after June 9, 1988. (a) Every fire department, except volunteer fire 18 departments, in the state shall formulate a written plan to implement the requirements of NFPA 19 1500 no later than one hundred eighty (180) days after the effective date of this act, which shall

be updated annually, and a copy shall be given to the director of the department of labor and 1 2 training to be kept on file, and a copy shall be given to the bargaining agent representing the 3 employees within the fire department. A copy of each applicable fire department's NFPA 1500 4 implementation plan shall be forwarded by the department of labor and training to the NFPA 5 1500 implementation plan review committee within thirty (30) days after its receipt by the 6 department of labor and training. The plan shall identify each specific requirement of NFPA 1500 7 for which the fire department currently complies and each specific requirement for which 8 corrective action must be initiated for compliance. The plan shall include a timetable for 9 corrective action. The written plan shall be made available for review by any fire department 10 employee and/or employee representative. Compliance for each specific requirement of NFPA 11 1500 shall be accomplished no later than three (3) years after the effective date of this act. 12 23-28.4-5.1. NFPA 1500 Implementation Plan Review Committee -- Creation and membership. -- There is hereby created a NFPA 1500 Implementation Plan Review Committee 13 14 consisting of three (3) members: one (1) of whom shall be appointed by the Rhode Island League of Cities and Towns, one (1) of whom shall be appointed by the Rhode Island State Association 15 16 of Fire Fighters, and one (1) of whom shall be appointed by the Rhode Island Fire Chiefs' 17 Association. The terms of all members shall be for four (4) years. 18 The NFPA Implementation Plan Review Committee shall meet at the call of the 19 chairperson, but not less than bi monthly to review the implementation plans as submitted by the 20 applicable fire departments pursuant to section 23-28.4-5. The Implementation Plan Review 21 Committee, after reviewing each fire department's implementation plan, shall make a report 22 available as to the progress of each applicable department's compliance or mncompliance with 23 NFPA 1500 by January 1, 2007. (a) There is hereby created a NFPA 1500 implementation plan 24 review committee consisting of five (5) members: one of whom shall be appointed by the 25 governor; one of whom shall be appointed by the senate majority leader; one of whom shall be 26 appointed by the speaker of the house; one of whom shall be appointed by the Rhode Island state 27 association of fire fighters; and one of whom shall be appointed by the Rhode Island fire chiefs 28 association. The terms of all members shall be for four (4) years. From the non-legislative 29 members the governor shall appoint one member to serve as chairperson, and one member to 30 serve as vice-chairperson. The terms of the chairperson and vice-chairperson shall be for four (4) 31 years, or until their successors are appointed. 32 (b) The implementation plan review committee shall meet at the call of the chairperson, 33 but not less than bi-monthly, to review the implementation plans as submitted by the applicable

34 fire departments. The implementation plan review committee, after reviewing each fire

- 1 departments implementation plan, shall make recommendations to the department of labor and
- 2 training as to the progress of each applicable department's compliance or non-compliance with
- 3 <u>NFPA 1500.</u>
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SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2012.
