It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 25-2 of the General Laws entitled "Days of Special Observance" is
2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 **25-2-53. Halloween.** – The last Saturday in the month of October shall annually be set
4 apart as "Halloween". The day may be observed by the people of this state with appropriate
5 exercises in public places.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
