It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 21-28-4.11 of the General Laws in Chapter 21-28 entitled "Uniform

2 Controlled Substances Act" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 <u>21-28-4.11. Second offenses. --</u> (A) Any person convicted of a second offense under this

chapter may be imprisoned for a term up to twice the term authorized, fined an amount up to

twice that authorized, or both. Provided, however, in the case of possession of marijuana a person

convicted of a second offense shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

7 (B) For purposes of this section, an offense is considered a second offense if, prior to his

or her conviction of the offense, the offender has at any time been convicted under this chapter or

under any statute of the United States or of any state relating to narcotic drugs, marijuana,

depressant, stimulant, or hallucinogenic drugs.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
