It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 7 named the Sgt. William G. Fournier Medal of Honor Bridge.
- 8 22-7.4-150. Sgt. William J. Babcock Medal of Honor Bridge.
- 9 Bridge number 17801, located on RI route 108, Kingstown Road, which spans the
- 10 Saugatucket River in the town of South Kingstown, shall hereafter be named the Sgt. William J.
- 11 Babcock Medal of Honor Bridge.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO GENERAL ASSEMBLY – PERMANANENT JOINT COMMITTEE ON NAMING ALL NEW BUILDINGS, BRIDGES, EDIFICES AND OTHER STATE CONTRUCTIONS

This act would rename three (3) bridges in the town of South Kingstown after three (3)
Medal of Honor recipients from that town. Specifically, bridge 00201 would be named the Sgt.
William G. Fournier Medal of Honor Bridge; bridge 17801 would be named the Sgt. William J.
Babcock Medal of Honor Bridge; and, bridge 17601 would be named the Cpl. David B. Champagne
Medal of Honor Bridge.
This act would take effect upon passage.
