It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 17-19-23.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 17-19 entitled "Conduct
of Election and Voting Equipment, and Supplies" is hereby amended to read as follows:
17-19-23.1. Certification and appointment of election officials. -- (a) All persons who attend and complete a program of instruction for election officials under section 17-7-5(a)(6) shall be issued a certificate by the board of elections. In addition to the compensation to which they are otherwise entitled, these persons shall also be entitled to receive the sum of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) upon the performance of their duties on election day. The cities and towns shall not be required to pay this sum. The certificate shall be valid for a period of one year; provided, that the certificate shall be revocable at the discretion of the board of elections if the board believes that new developments have occurred requiring the re-certification of these persons.
(b) Election officials shall, whenever practicable, be appointed from lists of certificated persons.
(c) The board of elections shall have the authority to adopt rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
