It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 17-19-23.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 17-19 entitled "Conduct
2	of Election and Voting Equipment, and Supplies" is hereby amended to read as follows:
3	17-19-23.1. Certification and appointment of election officials (a) All persons who
4	attend and complete a program of instruction for election officials under section 17-7-5(a)(6)
5	shall be issued a certificate by the board of elections. In addition to the compensation to which
6	they are otherwise entitled, these persons shall also be entitled to receive the sum of twenty-five
7	dollars (\$25.00) upon the performance of their duties on election day. The cities and towns shall
8	not be required to pay this sum. The certificate shall be valid for a period of one year; provided,
9	that the certificate shall be revocable at the discretion of the board of elections if the board
10	believes that new developments have occurred requiring the re-certification of these persons.
11	(b) Election officials shall, whenever practicable, be appointed from lists of certificated
12	persons.

- 13 (c) The board of elections shall have the authority to adopt rules and regulations to carry
- 14 out the provisions of this section.
- 15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
