It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 10-16-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 10-16 entitled "Small
Claims and Consumer Claims" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 10-16-1. Actions subject to chapter. - (a) In all ex contractu civil actions and in any action to recover the amount of any tax for money only not in excess of two thousand five 4 hundred dollars (\$2,500) five thousand dollars (\$5,000) exclusive of interest and costs, and in all 5 6 actions or suits to recover damages resulting from a retail sale of tangible personal property to a 7 member of the general public or from services rendered to a member of the general public in 8 which the plaintiff seeks to recover an amount of money only not in excess of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) five thousand dollars (\$5,000) exclusive of interest and costs, and in all 9 10 actions or suits based upon a negotiable instrument involving an amount of money only not in 11 excess of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) five thousand dollars (\$5,000) exclusive of 12 interest and costs, the procedure shall, at the plaintiff's election, shown by his or her waiver of 13 appeal, be as provided by this chapter. 14 (b) The jurisdictional dollar amount as provided for under this section shall be subject to

15 <u>future increases based upon the consumer price index (CPI) one year after the effective date of</u>

16 this section, and annually thereafter.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

1 This act would increase the jurisdiction of matters in small claims court from two 2 thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) to five thousand (\$5,000) and would allow for future

3 increases based upon the consumer price index (CPI) at that time.
