DECLARING THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY TO BE "NATIONAL TEEN DATING VIOLENCE AWARENESS AND PREVENTION MONTH" IN THE STATE OF RHODE ISLAND

1 WHEREAS, Dating violence is a reality for many youth, and an issue that many parents 2 are unaware of; and WHEREAS, One in three young people are affected by physical, sexual, or verbal dating 3 4 violence, with one in five in a serious relationship reporting having been slapped, pushed, hit, 5 threatened or coerced by a partner, and breakups can be a time of even greater risk, even when a relationship was never physically abusive; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Young people can choose better relationships when they understand that healthy relationships are based on respect, and learn to identify early warning signs of an abusive 8 9 relationship; and 10 WHEREAS, Elimination of dating violence must be achieved through the cooperation of 11 individuals, organizations and communities; and 12 WHEREAS, Dating Violence Awareness and Prevention Month provides an excellent 13 opportunity for citizens to learn more about preventing dating violence and to show support for 14 the numerous organizations and individuals who provide critical advocacy, services, and 15 assistance to victims; now, therefore be it 16 RESOLVED, That this House of Representatives of the State of Rhode Island and 17 Providence Plantations herby proclaims the month of February 2011 to be "National Teen Dating

Violence Awareness and Prevention Month". We call upon all Rhode Islanders to support efforts

in their communities and schools, and in their own families, to empower young people to develop

- 1 healthy relationships throughout their lives and to engage in activities that prevent and respond to
- 2 teen dating violence; and be it further
