It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 42-66.9-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 42-66.9 entitled
"Housing for the Elderly - Emergency Generators Required" is hereby amended to read as
follows:

4 <u>42-66.9-1. Emergency generators required. --</u> All housing for the elderly complexes, as 5 defined in section 42-66.1-2, which are serviced by one or more elevators and/or electrically 6 powered chair lifts, and which include more than <u>one hundred fifty (150) one hundred (100)</u> 7 residential living units in a single building shall be equipped with emergency generators which 8 shall provide sufficient power to provide emergency lighting to all common areas and a 9 community room and power to operate the elevators and a refrigerator in a common area. 10 Generator systems shall be in accordance with the national electric code and section 23-28.24-9.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on March 1, 2014.

1 This act would lower from one hundred fifty (150) to one hundred (100) the number of

2 units required for an elderly housing complex to be required to maintain an emergency generator.

This act would take effect on March 1, 2014.

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
