HOUSE RESOLUTION

PROCLAIMING APRIL, 2011, AS "AUTISM AWARENESS MONTH" IN THE STATE OF RHODE ISLAND

1 WHEREAS, Autism is a neurological disorder that profoundly affects a person's ability 2 to communicate, process, and respond to sensory information, making it difficult for them to 3 relate to others and the world around them; and 4 WHEREAS, Autism is the fastest-growing developmental disability in the United States, affecting 1 in 110 children, and, based on statistics from the United States Department of 5 6 Education and other governmental agencies, Autism is growing at a startling rate of 10 to 17 7 percent per year. At this rate, the Autism Society of America estimates that the prevalence of 8 Autism could reach four million Americans in the next decade; and 9 WHEREAS, Typically appearing during the first three years of life, Autism is the result 10 of a neurological disorder that affects the normal functioning of the brain. Autism knows no 11 racial, ethnic, or social boundaries, but is three to four times more prevalent in boys than in girls; 12 and 13 WHEREAS, Over the past several years, significant progress has been made in the areas 14 of research, diagnostic practices, and therapies for individuals with Autism; and 15 WHEREAS, A variety of causes, including environmental toxins, childhood immunizations, and genetics, are all being studied in relation to Autism, but to date, there is no 16 identifiable cause or cure for Autism; and 17

WHEREAS, Research indicates that early, intensive, sustained, and appropriate

intervention can result in significant improvements in the quality of life, level of independent
