It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 42-64 of the General Laws entitled "Rhode Island Commerce
- 2 Corporation" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>42-64-7.14. Recreational facility exemption.</u>
- 4 Notwithstanding the express powers granted to the commerce corporation by §§42-64-6
- 5 and 42-64-7, the corporation, without express general assembly approval by resolution, shall not
- 6 loan any funds or provide financial assistance of any kind or nature of more than five million
- 7 <u>dollars (\$5,000,000).</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE AFFAIRS AND GOVERNMENT - COMMERCE CORPORATION

This act would prohibit the state commerce corporation, without express general assembly approval by resolution, from loaning any funds or financial assistance of more than five million dollars (\$5,000,000).

This act would take effect upon passage.
