The purpose of said commission shall be to make a comprehensive study of the provision 5 of fire service in the state, and shall include, but not be limited to: 6 7 (1) The impact of collective bargaining agreements or state statutes on the operation of 8 and the cost of operating fire departments; 9 (2) The effect of merging or consolidating fire departments; 10 (3) The effect of bifurcation of functions within a fire department; and 11 (4) Any other matter affecting the manner of, operation of, or cost of, a fire department. 12 Forthwith upon passage of this resolution, the members of the commission shall meet at 13 the call of the Speaker of the House and organize and shall select a chairperson from among the 14 Vacancies in said commission shall be filled in like manner as the original legislators. 15 appointment. 16 The membership of said commission shall receive no compensation for their services. 17 All departments and agencies of the state shall furnish such advice and information,

documentary and otherwise, to said commission and its agents as is deemed necessary or

desirable by the commission to facilitate the purposes of this resolution.

- 3 RESOLVED, That the commission shall report its findings and recommendations to the
