13	37-2-56.1. Consolidated advertising program The advertising and/or media
14	expenses for all state departments and/or quasi public agencies or entities shall be administered
15	by the department of administration. Quasi-public agencies or entities shall-utilize and participate
16	in state master price agreement contracts for the purchase of any advertising and/or media
17	services. The department of administration shall assist quasi-public agencies or entities in
18	facilitating the negotiation and use of state master price agreement contracts for the purchase of

- 1 advertising and/or media services. The savings realized from this consolidated advertising
- 2 program through the use of state master price agreement contracts shall be directed into the
- 3 general fund.
