It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3-6-11 of the General Laws in Chapter 3-6 entitled "Manufacturing
2 and Whole sale Licenses" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 **3-6-11. Wholesaler's Class C license.** -- A wholesaler's Class C license authorizes the
4 holder to manufacture, transport, import, export, deliver, and sell alcohol for mechanical,
5 manufacturing, medicinal, or chemical purposes only, or to any registered pharmacist, licensed
6 pharmacy, drug store, or apothecary shop, or to any registered physician or dentist, or to any
7 hospital or educational or scientific institution, for use other than beverage purposes or to a
8 bakery, to be used only for cooking or baking purposes, provided said bakery uses an annual
9 minimum of one thousand (1,000) gallons of alcohol. The annual fee for the license is two
10 hundred dollars (\$200) and shall be paid to the division of taxation and turned over to the general
11 treasurer for the use of the state.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION
BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
OF
A N A C T
RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES - MANUFACTURING AND WHOLESALE
LICENSES

1 This act would allow the holder of a Class C wholesalers liquor license to sell alcoholic
2 beverages directly to bakeries to be used for cooking or baking purposes only if those bakeries
3 use a minimum of one thousand (1,000) gallons of alcohol each year.

4 This act would take effect upon passage.
