It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 46-22 of the General Laws entitled "Regulation of Boats" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>46-22-13.2. Bridge safety.</u> All ships over one hundred fifty feet (150') in length whose
- 4 primary cargo is hazardous material shall have at least twenty-five feet (25') of clearance under
- 5 all of Rhode Island's bridges. This section shall not apply to boats under sail.
- 6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
