It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 23-28.22-18 of the General Laws in Chapter 23-28.22 entitled
- 2 "Flammable and Combustible Liquids" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>23-28.22-18. Minimum age requirement.</u> No person under the age of sixteen (16)
- 4 years of age shall operate a gasoline dispensing device at a self service station. No retail dealer of
- 5 gasoline or other motor fuel as defined in subdivision 5-55-3(11) shall employ for the purpose of
- 6 dispensing such fuel any person under the age of sixteen (16) years of age, but any person sixteen
- 7 (16) years of age or older may be so employed, any other statute or regulation to the contrary
- 8 notwithstanding.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
