- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-37-3 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-37 entitled "Sexual
- 2 Assault" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 11-37-3. Penalty for first degree sexual assault.
- 4 Every person who shall commit sexual assault in the first degree shall be imprisoned for a
- 5 period not less than ten (10) fifteen (15) years; provided that, the first ten (10) years shall be served
- 6 and the person shall not be afforded the benefits of deferment or suspension of sentence and may
- 7 be imprisoned for life.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and shall be applicable to all those
- 9 offenses committed after the effective date of this section.
