It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 42-10 of the General Laws entitled "Treasury Department" is
2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 **42-10-13.2. Entities to receive state financial grants in excess of five thousand**
4 **(\$5,000) to have signature of a senator and a representative.** – [Before any application can be](#)
5 [considered for a non-educational grant in excess of five thousand dollars \(\\$5,000\) from any state](#)
6 [agency, the application must have the signature of one senator and one representative of the city](#)
7 [or town where the applicant is domiciled. The application is not complete and shall not be](#)
8 [considered without such signatures.](#)

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION
BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO STATE AFFAIRS AND GOVERNMENT - TREASURY DEPARTMENT

1 This act would provide that in order for an application to be considered for a non-
2 educational grant, where the amount requested is in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000), the
3 application must have the signature of the senator and representative of the city or town where the
4 applicant is domiciled.

5 This act would take effect upon passage.
