It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 42-10 of the General Laws entitled "Treasury Department" is

hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

42-10-13.2. Entities to receive state financial grants in excess of five thousand 3

(\$5,000) to have signature of a senator and a representative. – Before any application can be

5 considered for a non-educational grant in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) from any state

agency, the application must have the signature of one senator and one representative of the city 6

7 or town where the applicant is domiciled. The application is not complete and shall not be

8 considered without such signatures.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
