It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 16-21 of the General Laws entitled "Health and Safety of Pupils" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- **16-21-21.2. Student's bill of rights.**
- 4 No pupil attending public or private schools of elementary and high school grades
- 5 inclusive of kindergarten shall be discriminated against on the basis of race, color, religion,
- 6 <u>ancestry, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, socioeconomic</u>
- 7 status or mental, physical, developmental, or sensory disability, or by association with an
- 8 individual or group who has, or is perceived to have one, or more of such characteristics.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
