It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 31-22-11.8 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-22 entitled 2 "Miscellaneous Rules" is hereby amended to read as follows: 31-22-11.8. Unauthorized use of cell phones on school bus. -- (a) The use of a cell 3 4 phone by a school bus driver or student shall be prohibited, while the bus is transporting children 5 except in the case of an emergency. 6 (b) Any person who violates any of the provisions of subsection (a) of this section shall, 7 upon conviction, be punished by a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00). 8 (c) For a subsequent conviction under this section a person shall be punished by a fine of 9 fifty dollars (\$50.00). (d)(c) If any civil action is brought as a result of a violation of this section, the violation 10 shall be evidence of negligence. 11 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
