It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 31-27 of the General Laws entitled "Motor Vehicle Offenses" is
- 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 31-27-26. Prompt violation payment.
- 4 Any motorist who receives a moving violation, which fine may be paid without a court
- 5 appearance, and who pays the fine in full within thirty (30) days of its issuance, shall not have the
- 6 violation recorded on the motorist's department of motor vehicle's driving record; provided,
- 7 however, that this procedure may not be utilized more than twice a year.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES - TRAFFIC OFFENSES

This act would prohibit the department of motor vehicles from placing on a motorist's driving record, no more than twice yearly, a traffic violation which fine has been paid no longer than thirty (30) days after its issuance.

This act would take effect upon passage.
