It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 17-2 of the General Laws entitled "General State Officers" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

17-2-4.1. Vacancies in the office of lieutenant governor. – If the office of lieutenant governor shall become vacant or shall have become vacant by reason of death, resignation or otherwise, the general assembly in grand committee shall elect a person who would otherwise be eligible to both run for the office and hold the office of lieutenant governor pursuant to the constitution of the state of Rhode Island, to fill said vacancy.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
