#### RELATING TO EDUCATION - ELIGIBILITY FOR ATTENDANCE

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 16-2-27 and 16-2-28 of the General Laws in Chapter 16-2 entitled
"School Committees and Superintendents" are hereby amended to read as follows:

16-2-27. Eligibility for attendance -- Kindergarten. – (a) Every child who has attained
or will have attained five (5) years of age on or before September 1 of any school year shall be

5 eligible to attend kindergarten during all the days that the kindergartens are in session during the

school year.

(b) If space is available, school departments shall consider requests for enrollment in kindergarten for children who will have completed five (5) years of age after September 1 of the school year, but before December 31<sup>st</sup> of that same school year. Requests of this nature shall be considered and evaluated in accordance with guidelines issued by the department of elementary and secondary education, and the department of elementary and secondary education is hereby authorized and directed to promulgate such guidelines. Provided, this subsection shall not require a school department to admit a child to kindergarten if the department determines such admission would not be in the child's best interests.

<u>16-2-28. Eligibility for attendance -- First grade. --</u> Every child who has completed or will have completed six (6) years of life on or before September 1 of any school year, <u>as well as any younger child who entered and successfully completed a kindergarten program pursuant to the provisions of subsection 16-2-27(b), or who has completed kindergarten shall be eligible to attend first grade during all the days that the public schools are in session during the school year.</u>

- 1 Every child shall be eligible to attend first grade only upon completion of a state recognized or
- 2 accredited kindergarten program.
- 3 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
