It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 23-4.6-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 23-4.6 entitled "Consent

2 to Medical and Surgical Care" is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 3 23-4.6-1. Consent to medical and surgical care.
- 4 (a) Any person of the age of sixteen (16) or over or married may consent to routine,
- 5 emergency, medical or surgical care. A minor parent may consent to treatment of his or her child.
- 6 (b) In addition to the provisions of subsection (a) of this section, any person, including,
- 7 <u>but not limited to, a minor who is pregnant, may give effective consent for medical, dental, health</u>
- 8 and hospital services relating to prenatal, delivery, and post-delivery care. The attending
- 9 physician shall comply with § 40-11-3. Consent shall not be given pursuant to this subsection for
- 10 <u>abortion or sterilization.</u>
- 11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
