- 1 SECTION 1. Section 7-1.2-1308 of the General Laws in Chapter 7-1.2 entitled "Rhode
- 2 Island Business Corporation Act" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 7-1.2-1308. Articles of dissolution. -- The corporation shall execute articles of
- dissolution by its authorized officer. The statement proclaims: 4
- 5 (a) The name of the corporation.
- 6 (b) That all debts, obligations, and liabilities of the corporation have been paid and,
- 7 discharged or have been subject to a completed bankruptcy proceeding under Title 11 of the U.S.
- 8 Code discharged or that adequate provision has been made for the payment.
- 9 (c) That all the remaining property and assets of the corporation have been distributed
- 10 among its shareholders in accordance with their respective rights and interests.
- 11 (d) That there are not suits pending against the corporation in any court, or that adequate
- 12 provision has been made for the satisfaction of any judgment, order, or decree which may be
- entered against it in any pending suit. 13
- 14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
