It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 17-1-5 of the General Laws in Chapter 17-1 entitled "General
 Provisions" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>17-1-5. Effect of special statutes. --</u> The provisions of any chapter or section under this 4 title are subject to the provisions of any special statutes respecting any particular town or city, 5 none of which are repealed by this title; provided, that insofar as any special statute passed prior 6 to April 22, 1935, conflicts with the provisions of chapter 19 of this title, the provisions of chapter 7 19 shall prevail; and provided, further, that insofar as any special statute conflicts with the 8 provisions of section <u>17-14-7</u>, <u>17-14-9</u>, or <u>17-19-7.1</u> of this title, the provisions of section <u>17-14-7</u>, <u>17-14-9</u>, or <u>17-19-7.1</u> shall prevail.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

1 This act would provide that the provisions of the general laws relating to the number of

2 signers required for nomination papers and for the number of papers signed by the same voter to

3 supersede any general or public law to the contrary.
