1 WHEREAS, Rhode Island General Law Title 42 Chapter 28.1 established an incentive 2 pay plan program to encourage law enforcement officers to garner a college degree and work 3 collaboratively with academia to address modern policing issues and learn the criminal justice 4 system from an academic view; and 5 WHEREAS, The net benefit of this program would be to provide the State's populace with both properly trained and college-educated officers who possess the best skill set in order to 6 7 deliver the highest outcomes expected in policing; and 8 WHEREAS, The 2015 President's Task Force on 21st-Century Policing stated that 9 college-educated police officers are 40 percent less likely to use force, are more problem-solving-10 orientated and critical thinkers, relate better to the community, can identify best practices, and are 11 better leaders; now, therefore be it 12 RESOLVED, That there is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated for the fiscal year 2024-2025, the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) 13 to the Rhode Island Department of Labor and Training to encourage members of the State, City, 14 15 and Town police departments to seek a college degree; and the state controller is hereby

authorized and directed to draw his orders upon the general treasurer for the payment of said sum,

upon receipt of properly authenticated vouchers.
