It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

Title 42 of the General Laws entitled "STATE AFFAIRS AND 2 GOVERNMENT" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following chapter: 3 **CHAPTER 162** COMPOSITION OF FIRE DISTRICT AND PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT BOARDS OF 4 5 **COMMISSIONERS 42-162-1. Fire districts.** 6 7 Any individual receiving a pension from the State of Rhode Island shall be allowed to serve 8 in any capacity on fire district boards or commissions. No compensation of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) or less for chairpersons; five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or less for officers; and one 9 10 thousand dollars (\$1,000) or less for members on the fire department and volunteer department and cities and towns boards and commissions or hours worked for said compensation shall be reported 11 12 to any agency of the state except for the purposes of taxation. 13 42-162-2. Pascoag utility district. 14 The Pascoag utility district created by chapter 58 of title 45 shall allow any individual receiving a pension from the State of Rhode Island to serve in any capacity on its board of utility 15

commissioners. No compensation of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) or less for chairpersons; five

thousand dollars (\$5,000) or less for officers; and one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or less for members

on the fire department and volunteer department and town boards and commissions or hours

- 1 worked for said compensation shall be reported to any agency of the state except for the purposes
- of taxation.
