2 Blackstone River ecosystem; and 3 WHEREAS, Currently, one of the most devastating invasive plants along the Blackstone 4 River is the Water Chestnut; and WHEREAS, These invasive species often grow quickly or have another competitive 5 advantage over native plants and can dominate the ecosystem, displacing natives species and 6 7 impeding swimming, fishing, and boating in the infested habitat; now, therefore be it 8 RESOLVED, That there is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the treasury not 9 otherwise appropriated for the fiscal year 2022-2023, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars 10 (\$100,000) to the Department of Environmental Management to fund and assist the City of 11 Central Falls in implementing aerial spraying and other methods to inhibit the growth and spread 12 of Water Chestnuts and other invasive species along the Blackstone River and nearby residual 13 ponds; and the state controller is hereby authorized and directed to draw his orders upon the 14 general treasurer for the payment of said sum, or so much thereof as may be from time to time
