RELATING TO EDUCATION -- HIGHER EDUCATION

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 16-59-28 of the General Laws in Chapter 16-59 entitled "Board of
- 2 Governors for Higher Education" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>16-59-28. "Bachelors Degree in Three" program. --</u> (a) The Rhode Island board of
- 4 governors for higher education shall establish and administer the "Bachelors Degree in Three"
- 5 program. The board shall:
- 6 (1) Establish guidelines for the "Bachelors Degree in Three" program.
- 7 (2) Collaborate with the board of regents for elementary and secondary education to
- 8 establish a seamless credit transfer system for high school students and other policies that might
- 9 facilitate student participation in such a program.
- 10 (3) Identify and propose any necessary changes to academic courses of study, support
- services, financial aid, and other policies and resources at the University of Rhode Island, Rhode
- 12 Island College and the Community College of Rhode Island to ensure greater opportunities for
- students to complete bachelors degree programs in three (3) years.
- 14 (4) Identify potential costs of the program, including costs to students, to the institutions,
- and to school districts, identify possible sources of external grant funding for a pilot program, and
- propose a funding structure for the program.
- 17 (5) Investigate accreditation issues and federal financial aid rules that may be implicated
- 18 by the program.
- 19 (6) Identify units at the University of Rhode Island, Rhode Island College, and the

- 1 Community College of Rhode Island that will assume administrative responsibility for the
- 2 program.
- 3 (7) Design, undertake and evaluate a three (3) year pilot program that will serve as a
- 4 model for full-scale implementation.
- 5 (b) The board shall present an initial report, recommendations and timeline to the general
- 6 assembly on or by February 1, 2010 2011, and the pilot program will begin with the fall academic
- 7 semester of 2010 <u>2011</u>.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
