It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 3-8-11.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 3-8 entitled "Regulation of
2	Sales" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3	3-8-11.1. Furnishing or procurement of alcoholic beverages for underage persons
4	(a) As used in this section: (1) "furnish" means to provide with, supply, give or purchase; (2)
5	"procure" means to get possession of, obtain by particular care and effort; and (3) "permit" means
6	to give permission for, or approval of, the possession or consumption of an alcoholic beverage by
7	any form of conduct, that would cause a reasonable person to believe that permission or approval
8	has been given.
0	(b) Execut as otherwise provided in subsection (c) of this section it is unlewful for any

(b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (c) of this section it is unlawful for any 9 10 person twenty one (21) years of age or older:

11 (1) to purchase from any licensee or any employee of a licensee any alcoholic beverage 12 for the sale, delivery, service of or giving away to, any person who has not reached his or her 13 twenty-first (21st) birthday;

14 (2) to purchase from any licensee or any employee of any licensee any alcoholic 15 beverage with the intent to cause or permit said alcoholic beverage to be sold, or given to any 16 person who has not reached his or her twenty-first (21st) birthday;

17 (3) to knowingly furnish any alcoholic beverage for the sale, delivery, service of or 18 giving to any person who has not reached his or her twenty-first (21st) birthday;

(4) to procure alcoholic beverages for the sale, delivery, service of or giving to any

1 person who has not reached his or her twenty-first (21st) birthday; or

2 (5) to otherwise permit the consumption of alcohol by underaged persons in his or her 3 residence or on his or her real property.

4 (c) This section does not apply to use, consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages 5 by a minor for religious purposes; or to a parent or legal guardian procuring or furnishing alcohol to, or permitting the consumption of alcohol by, his or her minor child or ward. 6

(d) Any person who violates this section will be subject to the penalties provided in 8 section 3-8-11.2.

9 SECTION 2. Chapter 31-27 of the General Laws entitled "Motor Vehicle Offenses" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 10

11 31-27-24. Furnishing or procurement of alcoholic beverages and/or controlled 12 substances for underage persons resulting in death. -- (a) When the death of any person ensues 13 as a proximate result of an injury received by the operation of any vehicle, the operator of which 14 is under the influence of any intoxicating liquor, toluene or any controlled substance as defined in 15 chapter 21-28, or any combination thereof, and who has not reached his or her twenty-first (21^{st}) 16 birthday, any person who furnished or procured the alcoholic beverage or controlled substance for 17 said operator in violation of section 3-8-11.1, the furnishing or procurement being the proximate 18 cause of such death, shall be guilty of furnishing or procurement of alcoholic beverages and/or 19 controlled substances for underage persons resulting in death. 20 (b) Any person charged with the commission of the offense set forth in subsection (a) of

21 this section shall, upon conviction, be imprisoned for not less than five (5) years and not more 22 than fifteen (15) years.

23 31-27-25. Furnishing or procurement of alcoholic beverages and/or controlled 24 substances for underage persons resulting in serious bodily injury. -- When serious bodily 25 injury of any person ensues as a proximate result of an injury received by the operation of any 26 vehicle, the operator of which is under the influence of any intoxicating liquor, toluene or any 27 controlled substance as defined in chapter 21-28, or any combination thereof, and who has not 28 reached his or her twenty-first (21st) birthday, any person who furnished or procured the alcoholic 29 beverage or controlled substance for said operator in violation of section 3-8-11.1, the furnishing 30 or procurement being the proximate cause of such serious bodily injury, shall be guilty of 31 furnishing or procurement of alcoholic beverages and/or controlled substances for underage 32 persons resulting in serious bodily injury. 33 (b) As used in this section, "serious bodily injury" means physical injury that creates a

substantial risk of death or causes serious physical disfigurement or protracted loss or impairment 34

- 1 <u>of the function of any bodily member or organ.</u>
- 2 (c) Any person charged with the commission of the offense set forth in subsection (a) of
- 3 this section shall, upon conviction, be imprisoned for not less than one year and not more than ten
- 4 <u>(10) years.</u>
- 5 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
