It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 39-2 of the General Laws entitled "Duties of Utilities and Carriers"

2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

- 3 <u>39-2-25. Removal of existing poles. --</u> <u>All utility companies are required to complete</u>
- 4 transfer of wires, all repairs, and removal of existing poles within three (3) months from the date
- 5 <u>of installation of a new pole.</u>
- 6 The owner of the poles must notify all other users of the starting date of the work. Any
- 7 violation of the provisions of this section shall be enforced by the public utility commission and
- 8 shall be subject to the violation to a fine in the amount of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) per
- 9 day, payable to the city or town where the pole is located.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

- 1 This act would require utility companies to remove utility poles within 3 months of
- 2 erecting a new pole and would impose a two hundred fifty dollar (\$250) fine.
- 3 This act would take effect upon passage.

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
