It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 5-34 of the General Laws entitled "Nurses" is hereby amended by 2 adding thereto the following section: 3 5-34-11.1. Professional nurse applicants -- Educational requirements -- Maintenance of license. – (1) All professional nurse applicants graduating with an associate's degree, or a 4 5 diploma from a nursing program, and licensed to practice in this state must attain a baccalaureate degree in nursing within ten (10) years of initial licensure. In its discretion, the department may 6 7 issue a conditional registration to a licensee who fails to complete the baccalaureate degree, but 8 who agrees to meet the requirement within one year. The fee for a conditional registration shall 9 be the same as that specified in section 5-34-12, and the duration of such conditional registration 10 shall be for one year. Any licensee who is notified of a denial of registration for failure to 11 complete the additional education requirements and who practices as a registered professional 12 nurse without such registration shall be subject to the provisions of section 5-34-29. 13 (2) The provisions of subdivision (1) shall not apply to: 14 (i) Any student entering a baccalaureate program preparing registered professional nurses after the effective date of this section; 15 16 (ii) Any student currently enrolled in, or having an application pending in a program 17 preparing registered nurses as of the effective date of this act; or 18 (iii) Any person already licensed as a registered professional nurse or any unlicensed

graduate professional nurse who is eligible to take the National Council Licensure Examination

- 1 <u>as of the effective date of this section.</u>
- 2 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO BUSINESSES AND PROFESSIONS - NURSES--EDUCATION

This act would require nurse applicants graduating with an associate's degree or diploma
from a nursing program to obtain a baccalaureate degree within ten (10) years of their initial
licensure. Students in baccalaureate program and persons already licensed as a registered
professional nurse or those unlicensed graduate professional nurses eligible to take the National
Council Licensure Examination would be exempt from such requirement.

This act would take effect upon passage.
