It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 34-4 of the General Laws entitled "Estates in Real Property" is
- 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>34-4-2.1. Reservation of life estate with enhanced powers. A grantor may convey</u>
- 4 <u>title to real estate and reserve a life estate therein coupled with the reserved power and authority,</u>
- 5 during his or her lifetime, to sell, convey, mortgage or otherwise dispose of the real estate without
- 6 the consent or joinder of the holders of the remainder interest. A duly-executed conveyance by
- 7 the life tenant exercising such reserved powers shall, upon recording, vest good title to the
- 8 interest conveyed in the grantee thereof, free and clear of any right, title and interest of the
- 9 holders of the remainder interest and without the necessity of any additional conveyance by any
- 10 <u>such remainderman.</u>
- 11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO PROPERTY

1 This act would in real estate recognize an enhanced life estate which empowers the 2 grantor who reserved a life estate to sell, convey, mortgage or dispose of real estate without the 3 consent of the holder of the remainder interest.

4 This act would take effect upon passage.
