RELATING TO HEALTH AND SAFETY - STROKE PREVENTION AND TREATMENT ACT OF 2009

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 23-78.1-4 of the General Laws in Chapter 23-78.1 entitled "Stroke
- 2 Prevention and Treatment Act of 2009" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>23-78.1-4. Acute care hospitals. --</u> (a) All acute care hospitals shall maintain readiness

4 to treat stroke patients. This shall include:

- 5 (1) Adherence with American Heart Association/American Stroke Association
 6 guidelines;
- 7 (2) Establishment of written care protocols for the treatment of ischemic and
 8 hemorrhagic stroke patients, including transfer of acute stroke patients to a primary stroke center
 9 as appropriate and medically indicated;
- (3) Participation in Get With The Guidelines/Stroke <u>or other national registry or database</u>
 to collect nationally recognized stroke measures and ensure continuous quality improvement;
- 12 (4) Participation in the Rhode Island Stroke Task Force and the Stroke Coordinators
- 13 Network to provide oversight for the stroke system of care and to share best practices.
- 14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

- 1 This act would expand the methods by which all acute care hospitals prepare for the
- 2 treatment of stroke patients.
