It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 23-17.9 of the General Laws entitled "Registration of Nursing
 Assistants" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 23-17.9-15. Regulation of administrators of medication by nursing assistants. -- The
- 4 director shall promulgate regulations permitting the administration of needles/injections,
- 5 prescriptions and nonprescription medications by certified nursing assistants, home health care
- 6 aides and medical technicians to individuals who are homebound (home based, shut-ins) or home
- 7 care services within the state of Rhode Island. Any regulations adopted under this section shall
- 8 include education and training to insure the health and safety of the patients.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH AND SAFETY

1 This act would require the director of health to promulgate regulations permitting the 2 administration of needle/injections, prescriptions and nonprescription medications by certified 3 nursing assistants, home health care aides and medical technicians to individuals who are 4 homebound or home care services within the state of Rhode Island.

This act would take effect upon passage.

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
