It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-5-8.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-5 entitled "Assaults" is

2 hereby amended to read as follows:

11-5-8.1. Assault with bodily fluid. -- Any person incarcerated or in custody at a state 3 4 correctional facility including the juvenile training school who shall knowingly and willfully 5 commit an assault upon a correctional officer or any other employee of the department of 6 corrections with any bodily fluid, while the employee is engaged in the performance of his or her 7 duty, shall be imprisoned not exceeding five (5) years, or fined not less than five hundred dollars 8 (\$500) nor more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000), or both. Any sentence imposed pursuant to 9 this section shall be imposed consecutively to, and not concurrently with, any sentence previously 10 imposed.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMINAL OFFENSES -- ASSAULTS

1 This act would require that any sentence imposed for the crime of assault with bodily

2 fluid would run consecutively to, and not concurrently with, any sentence previously imposed.

3 This act would take effect upon passage.
