It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 33-3-14 of the General Laws in Chapter 33-3 entitled "Division of

Real Estate" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 33-3-14. Certificate of descent. -- Prior to acceptance by the probate court of the final

account or affidavit of complete administration, the fiduciary shall submit to the probate court an

affidavit of no real property or a duly recorded certificate of descent which shall contain the name

and place of residence of each person to whom the real property, or any portion thereof or interest

7 therein is distributed, set out, or divided or descends, or a particular description of the estate,

8 portion, or interest distributed, set out, or divided or descending to each person. Said certificate of

descent shall be signed by the fiduciary provided, that there shall be no obligation on the part of a

probate court to prepare an affidavit of no real property or record a certificate of descent upon the

failure of the fiduciary to do so.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
