It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 45-19 of the General Laws entitled "Relief of Injured and Deceased 1

Fire Fighters and Police Officers" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

45-19-1.7. Continuation of payment of medical expenses upon retirement. --

Notwithstanding any provision of the general or public laws to the contrary, any retired person 4

eligible for receipt of pay and benefits pursuant to the provisions of section 45-19-1, shall 5

6 continue to have all medical, surgical, dental, optical, or other treatments, as well as, nursing,

attendants and hospital services, medicines, crutches and apparatus, paid for by the respective 7

city, town, fire district, or State of Rhode Island where said person was employed. 8

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
