It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23-17 of the General Laws entitled "Licensing of Health-Care
- 2 Facilities" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 **23-17-64. Influenza immunization.**
- 4 Between October 1 and March 1 of each year, each hospital shall offer, prior to
- 5 <u>discharge</u>, immunizations against influenza virus to all inpatients sixty-five (65) years of age and
- 6 older, unless contraindicated, and contingent upon the availability of the vaccine, in accordance
- 7 with the latest recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices of the
- 8 <u>Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH AND SAFETY -- LICENSING OF HEALTH CARE FACILITIES

This act would require hospitals to offer flu vaccinations to all inpatient individuals sixtyfive (65) years of age or older unless the person has a condition that would not allow such
vaccination or if the vaccine is in short supply.

This act would take effect upon passage.
