It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 31-17 of the General Laws entitled "Right-of-Way" is hereby 2 amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 31-17-5.2. Mobile equipment entry from private road or driveway. -- Any operator of 4 mobile equipment, as defined in section 31-1-9 when entering a public highway from a private 5 road or driveway, shall place warning devices, flares or rubber cones on the roadway to give motoring and pedestrian traffic notice of their intention to enter the highway. The operator shall 6 7 not drive their mobile equipment on the public highway unless it can be done with reasonable safety to all approaching highway vehicles or pedestrians. 8 9 SECTION 2. Section 31-17-5.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-17 entitled "Right-of-10 Way" is hereby amended to read as follows: 11 31-17-5.1. Penalties. -- Any person who violates any provision of sections 31-17-1 -- 31-12 17-5, 31-17-5.2 pertaining to the right-of-way of pedestrians, upon conviction, shall be sentenced

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
